We made it through the first week of school! What an amazing class we have. I am so excited for everything we will learn and do this year.

During this first week we have gotten to know each other and created classroom expectations. From this, I will create our classroom behavior plan which will start on Monday. Please be on the lookout for a monthly behavior sheet that will start coming home Monday. On the back will be a calendar with important dates.

Also coming home Monday will be a homework calendar. please be aware that students are responsible for copying down their homework every afternoon and gathering any worksheets or paper needed for the assignments. All homework should be put into their homework folder. Homework is assigned on a daily basis and is expected to be turned in the following day. If your child is having a difficult time completing the homework in a timely manner please contact me so that we can work on an alternative plan.

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Math: We are learning about various addition and subtraction strategies that will be used throughout the year as we start to work with double and triple digit addition and subtraction equations.

Language Arts: We will be working on describing the structure of a story and asking/ answering questions about a story. Students will be introduced to what Daily 5 looks like this year as well as increasing their reading stamina. mClass Reading assessments will be taking place during the first few weeks of school. More information will be sent home when testing is complete.

Social Studies: Students will be learning about the roles and responsibilities of citizens and the purpose of a government. They will also be expected to exemplify respect and appropriate social skills needed for working with diverse groups.

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
