Math: We will use the strategies we have been learning to solve addition and subtraction story problems.

Language Arts: We will be working on describing the structure of a story and asking/ answering questions about a story. Students will continue to work on Daily 5 and increasing their stamina. mClass Reading assessments are complete, information will be sent home with quarter 1 interims.
